
ORDER:

The Vice-Chancellor has approved the following recommendations of the Committee constituted to prepare regulations for under graduate courses under CBCS system with effect from the Academic year 2015-16 as follows:

1. to fix 35% (26 marks) of 75 marks as pass percentage in the external assessment and 40% (40 marks) of 100 (75+25) marks in the overall assessment for both theory and practical.
2. that there is no minimum pass marks percentage fixed for the internal assessment of theory and practical.
3. that a student who fails to secure over all 40% should re-appear for the external examination in the respective semester exam only and the internal assessment should be done during the course time in the respective semester only i.e., no repetition for internal assessment of theory and practical.
4. To allot the grades and corresponding points as detailed below
Absent – abs. -0
<40 - F - 0
40 - 49.99 - D
50 - 54.99 - C
55 - 59.99 - B
60 - 69.99 - B+
70 - 79.99 - A
80 - 89.99 - A+
90 - 100 - O
5. that there is no part - I and part -II segregation in the marks list of CBCS pattern
6. that VH, PH, sports and other similar concessions will be continued according to the Governments norms in the concerned academic year.
7. that there will not be semester wise grace grafting system in allotting semester end marks. However it can be considered at the end of the course as per the extent norms (Balamohandas committee).
8. that candidates who could not complete the course with in the period prescribed will be allowed to write examinations in the respective semester end exams only for two more years with the syllabus prescribed for his/her period of study. If fails to finish the course with in this period, he/she has to write examinations following changed syllabus in existence at that time.

9. That the formula for CGPA conversion into marks should be fixed as $CGPA \times 10$ as recommended by the UGC.
10. Revaluation norms remain as they are.
