INAGURAL ADDRESS

Inuagural address by
Prof. Mokka Jagannadha Rao
Hon’ble Vice-Chancellor

Professions exist to serve society. The physician prescribes and the pharmacist compound and dispenses it. In addition to dispensing medications and ensuring patient safety, today’s pharmacists are taking a larger role as medical counsellors.

Pharmacy profession expanding in new directions with dynamic, patient-oriented professionals committed to fulfilling the health care needs of their people.

Over the last 20 years, pharmacists’ role has transformed from product orientation services into patient-based services in many parts of the world.

In developing and industrialized countries alike, efforts to provide health care, including pharmaceutical care, are facing new challenges. These include the rising costs of health care, limited financial resources, a shortage of human resources in the health care sector, inefficient health systems, the huge burden of disease, and the changing social, technological, economic and political environment which most countries face. Access to medicines of assured quality remains a major concern worldwide.

“One great innovation WHO made was the creation of National Pharmaceutical Advisers for Medicines and Health Technologies, in 2001. The work of these professional advisers has allowed for proper coordination of all issues on medicines and health technologies in respect of effectiveness and efficiency of implementation of all aspects of medicines policy.

People of our country are aware of the role played by the pharma sector. Basically, if we look at the manufacturing, look at the cost of the medicines, look at the access of the medicines and look at the affordability of medicine it is all very superior in India compared to many countries across the world as the pharmacist and the manufacturing sector of R&D are doing exceedingly well.

Pharma sector depends upon the quality of life, being number one in the country but still for every five years the requirement change in this field, and the skill also accordingly has to be changed. The students training within this field should obtain themselves with the respective skills and updating of skills by keen focus on research.

Pharmacists and their teams are a vital healthcare provider during the outbreak of COVID -19 all over the globe they remain on the frontline of public health by serving as direct points of access for their patients.

Through preventative measures advocated by WHO, the pharmacists and public are working together in their respective countries to ‘flatten the curve’. With a global lockdown there seems to be an even greater dependence on pharmacists as the first point of contact to fulfil the public’s healthcare needs.

Pharmacists also continued to play their role towards public uninterrupted for regular supplies of medicines, as well as supporting governments for disseminating information on precautions related to COVID-19 spread including hand washing technique to availability of face masks and instructions for their proper use and disposal.

Lower Middle-Income Countries are in a greater need for pharmacists’ support where patients are unable to afford the doctor fees for a consultation. In absence of a standard treatment the importance of provision of pharmaceutical care by pharmacists managing the COVID-19 cases increased many-folds.

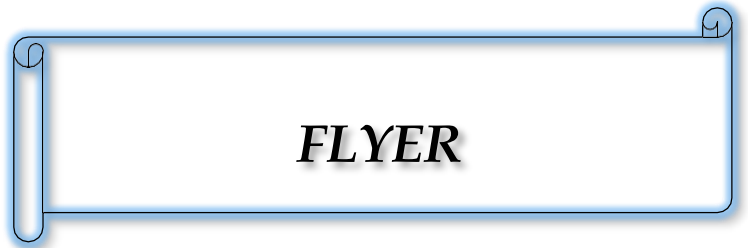
In fact, that there might be a number of challenges and barriers to optimized pharmacy services that can to be explored by quantitative and qualitative methods.

Pharmacists are also in a unique position to identify potential drug interactions, and to educate patients on the proper use of medication. Pharmacy of the world –more than 200 countries. Largest number of USFDA Units in the country outside USA- more than 260; 1400 WHO approved units. Largely dependent on API in China. Self Reliant Pharma – for Medicine Security Massive Investment for Bulk Drugs. Living with Corona: **SARS-CoV-2** (Severe Acute Respiratory Syndrome) No Medicine – No Vaccine as well. Medicine Discovery takes 10-15 years. Vaccines too take this long. Old drugs become ineffective: AMR Peoples’ longevity increased: need of medicines for age related issues. Emergence of new diseases: Zika Virus, Chikungunya, Dengue, COVID -19. No medicine is ideal: Need of improvement. Identification of new drug target: gene based molecular mechanism. Drug design based on biological mechanism: Drug Receptor mechanism, CADD. Chemical modification of known drug. Screening of known products –Natural products. Biotechnology and cloning. Fixed Dose Combinations. New Focus on Artificial Intelligence. Repurposing Old Drugs. Also known as Repositioning / Re-tasking / Reproofing. Why Repurposing for COVID- 19? Low risk of failure Requires less time for approval Less investment needed. Cost of development is about USD 300 -400 million against the cost for developing a new molecule USD 2-3 billion.

WHO launched on 18th March 2020. Over 100 countries including India participating. Open Label Randomised Multi Country Clinical Trial [It is neither double blind nor placebo controlled]. Prospective Interventional Study. Five alternatives Tested: Standard Care is the reference standard. India – Five Hospitals are already approved: Two from Ahmedabad, One from Chennai, One from Jodhpur, and One from Bhopal. National AIDS Research Institute – Coordination Centre.To extend to 20 sites. Sample size at least 1500. Four protocols: - Remdesivir, Lopinavir and Ritonavir combination, Hydroxychloroquine and Chloroquine, Lopinavir and ritonavir with Interferon beta-1a Highest likelihood of working; Availability of safety data from previous use.

Chances of availability of supplies in sufficient quantity to treat substantial numbers of patients if found effective. Antiviral compound to combat Ebola. Mechanism -inhibiting a key viral enzyme, the RNA dependent RNA polymerase and thus prevents virus replication. Congo: No effect against Ebola. Animal Testing: reduce the virus load in lung tissue of mice infected with MERS coronavirus, improve lung function and alleviate pathological damage to lung tissue. Anti-human immunodeficiency virus (HIV). *In vitro* and clinical studies have shown the effectiveness of this combination against coronavirus. Broad spectrum antiviral activity against SARS – CoV – 2 infection but it requires higher doses which could be potentially toxic. China Trial: Novel coronavirus patients treated with Chloroquine showed a better drop in fever and shorter recovery time. Chloroquine showed encouraging results in *in vitro* studies against dengue and chikungunya (both are viral diseases) – No clinical trial.

Gist of WHO Guidelines

12. Antivirals, immunomodulators and other adjunctive therapies for COVID-19

- ✘ We recommend that the following drugs not be administered as treatment or prophylaxis for COVID-19, outside of the context of clinical trials:
- Chloroquine and hydroxychloroquine (+/- azithromycin), including but not limited to:
 - Antivirals, including but not limited to:
 - Lopinavir/ritonavir
 - Remdesivir
 - Umifenovir
 - Favipiravir
 - Immunomodulators, including but not limited to:
 - Tocilizumab
 - Interferon-β-1a
 - Plasma therapy.

13. Corticosteroid therapy and COVID-19

- ✘ We recommend against the routine use of systemic corticosteroids for treatment of viral pneumonia.

Acute co-infections

We recommend for patients with:

- ✘ suspected or confirmed mild COVID-19, against the use of antibiotic therapy or prophylaxis;
- ✘ suspected or confirmed moderate COVID-19, that antibiotics should not be prescribed unless there is clinical suspicion of a bacterial infection;
- ✔ suspected or confirmed severe COVID-19, the use of empiric antimicrobials to treat all likely pathogens, based on clinical judgment, patient host factors and local epidemiology, and this should be done as soon as possible (within 1 hour of initial assessment if possible), ideally with blood cultures obtained first. Antimicrobial therapy should be assessed daily for de-escalation.

Antiviral Therapy

Recommendations

- The COVID-19 Treatment Guidelines Panel (the Panel) recommends the investigational antiviral agent **remdesivir** for treatment of COVID-19 in hospitalized patients with SpO₂ ≤94% on room air (at sea level) or those who require supplemental oxygen (**AI**).
- The Panel recommends **remdesivir** for treatment of COVID-19 in patients who are on mechanical ventilation or extracorporeal membrane oxygenation (**BI**).

Empiric Broad-Spectrum Antimicrobial Therapy

Recommendations

- In patients with COVID-19 and severe or critical illness, there are insufficient data to recommend empiric broad-spectrum antimicrobial therapy in the absence of another indication (**BIII**).
- If antimicrobials are initiated, the Panel recommends that their use should be reassessed daily in order to minimize the adverse consequences of unnecessary antimicrobial therapy (**AIII**).

Corticosteroids

Preliminary clinical trial data from a large, randomized, open-label trial suggest that dexamethasone reduces mortality in hospitalized patients with COVID-19 who require mechanical ventilation or supplemental oxygen.¹ The recommendations for using corticosteroids in patients with COVID-19 depend on the severity of illness. Before initiating dexamethasone, clinicians should review the patient's medical history and assess the potential risks and benefits of administering corticosteroids to the patient.

Recommendations

- The Panel recommends using dexamethasone (at a dose of 6 mg per day for up to 10 days) in patients with COVID-19 who are mechanically ventilated (**AI**) and in patients with COVID-19 who require supplemental oxygen but who are not mechanically ventilated (**BI**).
- The Panel **recommends against** using dexamethasone in patients with COVID-19 who do not require supplemental oxygen (**AI**).

Gist of Indian Guidelines

i. **Remdesivir** (under Emergency Use Authorization) may be considered in patients with moderate disease (those on oxygen) with none of the following contraindications:

- AST/ALT > 5 times Upper limit of normal (ULN)
- Severe renal impairment (i.e., eGFR < 30ml/min/m² or need for hemodialysis)
- Pregnancy or lactating females
- Children (< 12 years of age)

Dose: 200 mg IV on day 1 followed by 100 mg IV daily for 5 days

ii. **Convalescent plasma** (Off Label) may be considered in patients with moderate disease who are not improving (oxygen requirement is progressively increasing) despite use of steroids. Special prerequisites while considering convalescent plasma include:

Hydroxychloroquine: This drug has demonstrated in vitro activity against SARS-CoV2 and was shown to be clinically beneficial in several small single center studies though with significant limitations. Nonetheless, several large observational studies with severe methodologic limitations have shown no effect on mortality or other clinically meaningful outcomes. As such, the evidence base behind its use remains limited as with other drugs and should only be used after shared decision making with the patients while awaiting the results of ongoing studies. **As is the case with other antivirals, this drug should be used as early in the disease course as possible to achieve any meaningful effects and should be avoided in patients with severe disease.** An ECG should ideally be done before prescribing the drug to measure QTc interval (and HCQ avoided if QTc is >500 ms)

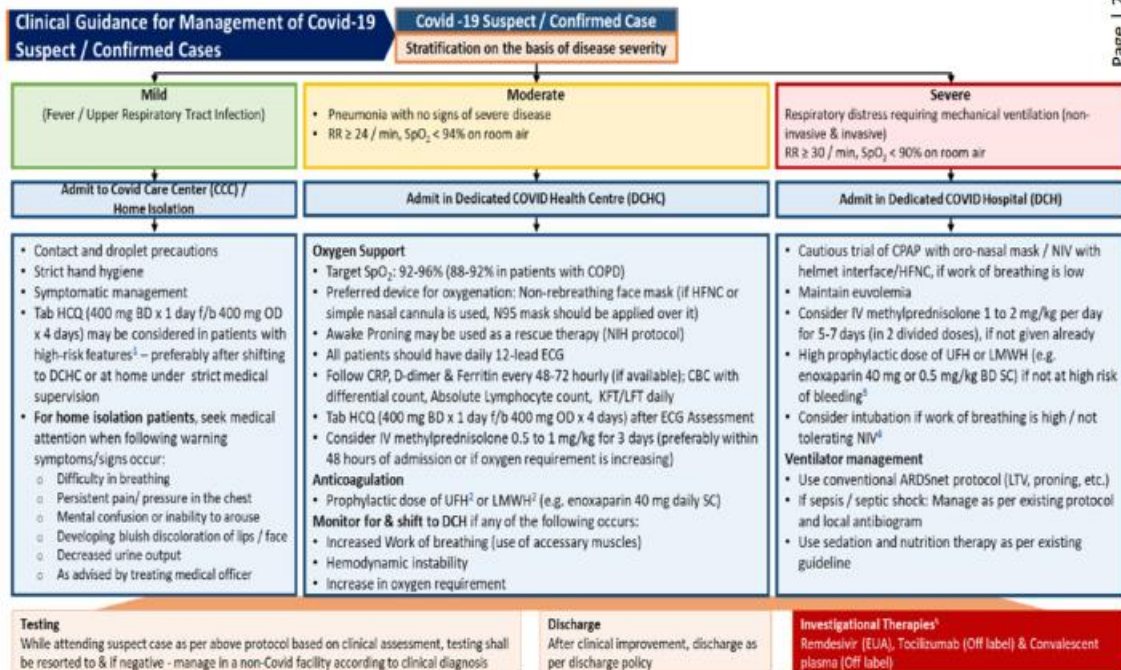
Dose: 400 mg BD on day 1 followed by 400mg daily for next 4 days.

iii. **Tocilizumab** (Off Label) may be considered in patients with moderate disease with progressively increasing oxygen requirements and in mechanically ventilated patients not improving despite use of steroids. Long term safety data in COVID 19 remains largely unknown. Special considerations before its use include:

- Presence of raised inflammatory markers (e.g., CRP, Ferritin, IL-6)
- Patients should be carefully monitored post Tocilizumab for secondary infections and neutropenia
- Active infections and Tuberculosis should be ruled out before use.

Dose: 8mg/kg (maximum 800 mg at one time) given slowly in 100 ml NS over 1 hour; dose can be repeated once after 12 to 24 hours if needed

This response was developed according to principles of evidence-based medicine and includes data from published prospective and retrospective studies (N≥40). Preprints of studies with N≥60 describing adverse events of special interest related to Actemra during treatment for COVID-19 are included.

In Brief

- Elevated levels of cytokines, including IL-6, have been observed in severely- or critically-ill COVID-19 patients. Actemra has been suggested to play a potential role in COVID-19 through its inhibition of IL-6, though the role of IL-6 in mediating cytokine storm associated with COVID-19 remains unclear.
- Actemra is not indicated for the treatment of COVID-19 pneumonia. At present, there are no well-controlled studies and very limited published evidence exists on the safety or efficacy of Actemra in the treatment of patients with COVID-19 pneumonia. The risks and benefits of treatment should be considered prior to initiating Actemra in patients with COVID-19.
