Please peruse the letter received from the Bar council Of India, New Delhi in connection with conduct of admissions and granting of affiliations from the universities to the law colleges. As per the guidelines prescribed by the BCI the respective universities have to complete affiliation process and the list of affiliated colleges have to be sent to the BCI for granting approvals before 31st December of every year.

Keeping in view of the hardship encountered in the current academic year it is opined that there is dire necessity to adhere to the schedule given by the Bar Council of India. Hence, the Vice Chancellors are requested to bestow their personal attention to take immediate action for granting approvals for the next academic year 2018-19 duly communicating the approved list by 31.12.2017 to Bar council of India.

Sub.: List of Law Colleges in the State of Andhra Pradesh eligible for admitting students in three year and five year integrated law courses for the Academic Year 2017-2018.

Sir,

This is with reference to your above noted letters requesting the Bar Council of India to furnish the approved list of law colleges in the State of Andhra Pradesh for admission of students to three year and five year law courses on the basis of APLAWCET-2017.

The matter of the law colleges in the State of Andhra Pradesh was placed before the Sub-Committee at its meeting held on 22.10.2017. After consideration the Committee was of the following view: -

Wherever any college has been granted or extended affiliation by the respective University, approval for the current academic year by the Bar Council of India may be issued forthwith, so that there is no further delay in the admission process.

In case where the inspection fee or default amount is due/to be remitted to the Bar Council of India by any institution, the approval may be extended or accorded, subject to payment of such amount within a period of 15 days from the date of receipt of the communication. If the amount is not paid within the stipulated time, the respective State Council of Higher Education shall not approve the admissions of students into such institutions.

It is pointed out that some of the colleges who have not submitted the affiliation order for the academic year 2017-2018 shall be required to submit the affiliation of the university before counseling. The colleges may submit the same directly to the Convener, APLAWCET-2017 alongwith submitting it simultaneously to the Bar Council of India. The State Council of Higher Education may approve the admissions of such students (allotted by the LAW CET) to such institution/s without waiting for any separate order from the Bar Council of India. However, the

LAWCET Convener shall forward all such particulars immediately and simultaneously to the Bar Council of India.


The approvals may be liable to be withdrawn by the Bar Council of India if the above procedure is not followed.

The Sub-Committee noted with a sense of dismay that the admission into Law Courses in the States of Andhra Pradesh and Telengana are delayed by several months on account of which the respective institutions are not able to attract students with good academic record. There should not be any problem in completing the process of granting of extension of affiliation by the concerned Universities latest by 31st December of each year. Many a time, though the entrance examination for admission into law courses are conducted in the month of July or August and results are announced, the admissions are delayed on account of inaction on the part of the respective State Councils of Higher Education. The matter is viewed very seriously and if the steps for early commencement of admission process not concluded by the end of August of each Academic year, the Bar Council of India would consider the feasibility of identifying alternative mechanism, in this regard.


Please find herewith a list of law colleges in Andhra Pradesh affiliated to various Universities, presently being given deemed approval or presently having approval of affiliation of the Bar Council of India and eligibility to admit students to the 1st year of the three year and five year law courses for the academic year 2017-2018, till further intimation/orders in this regard.

This letter is without prejudicing the rights of the Bar Council of India, to withdraw any approval at any point in time, subject to any default or non fulfillment of condition/conditions which has been, or which may be imposed upon the colleges or subject to any court directions in this regard.

If you, or any of the colleges wish to seek any clarification/s, the Bar Council of India, may be approached in this regard before beginning of the respective counseling process/es.
