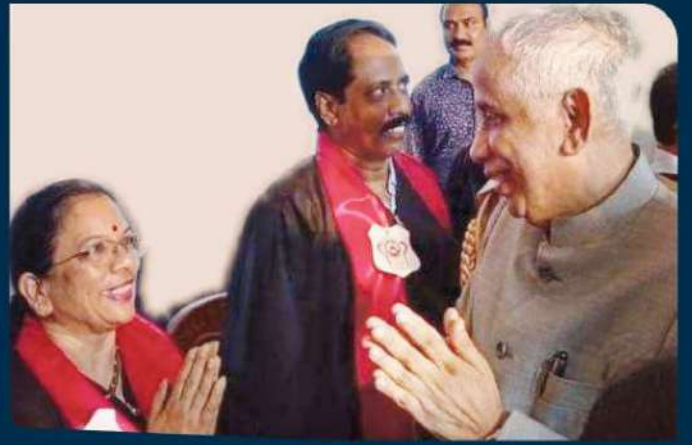
INITIATIVES AS THE VICE-CHANCELLOR OF AKNU

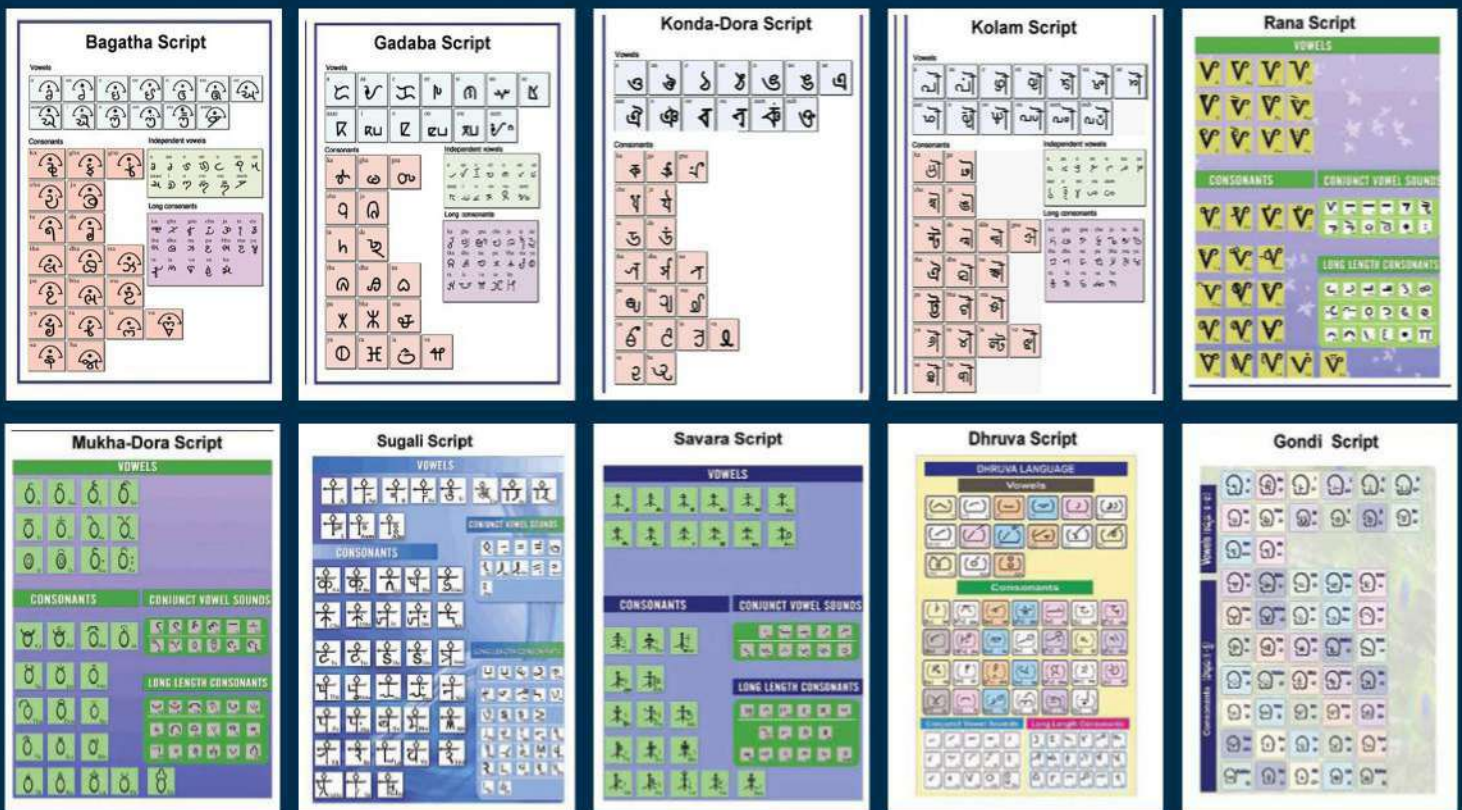

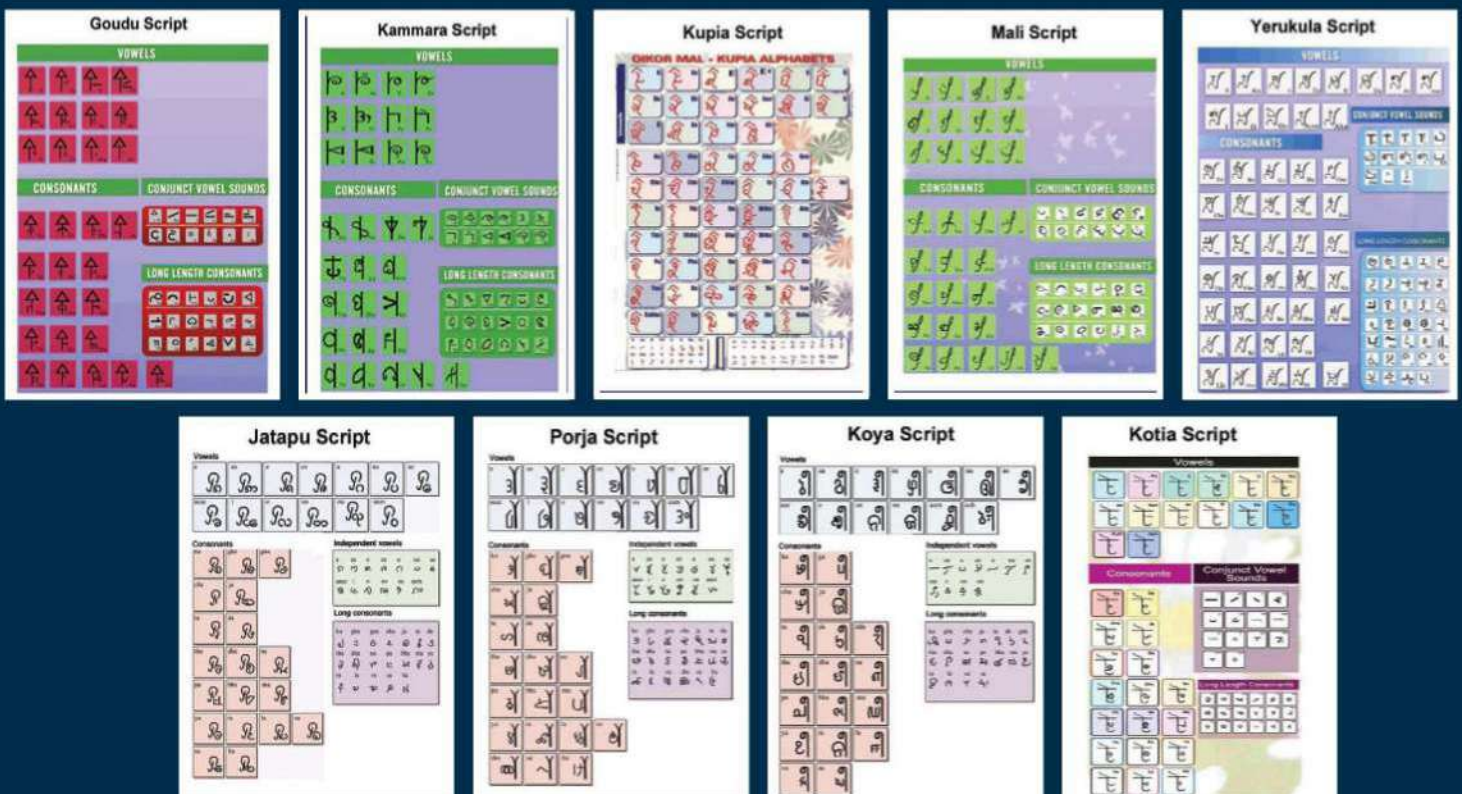
