About 70 students of M. Sc. Geophysics and M. Sc. Geology programs of the department along with research scholars and faculty members have participated in the webinar.

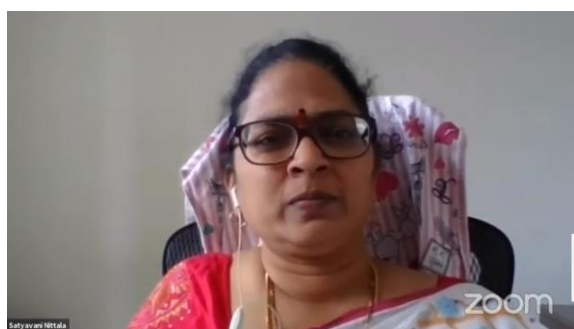
